October 25-29, 1971 and he described the planned actions. Drobenare mentioned that although the PCPJ and the NY MDC have had their differences in the past, there were several people in the PCPJ who would be happy to see the MDC coordinated with plans for increased militancy during October 25-29, 1971 demonstrations.

Drobenare announced that the National Peace Action Coalition (NPAC) and the PCPJ are co-sponsoring a National Moratorium Day on October 13, 1971 at which time all workers will be urged to strike in protest against the war. Drobenare mentioned that he had attended the last PCPJ meeting with Coca Crystal and Leslie Bacon.

A discussion was held as to whether the MDC should coordinate with PCPJ. It was generally agreed that the PCPJ scenario was too liberal and no definite decision was made on supporting it.

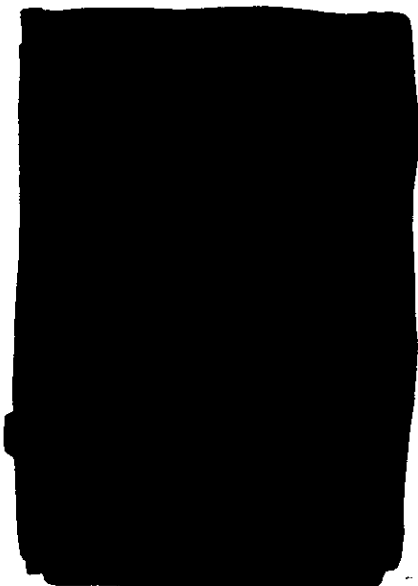

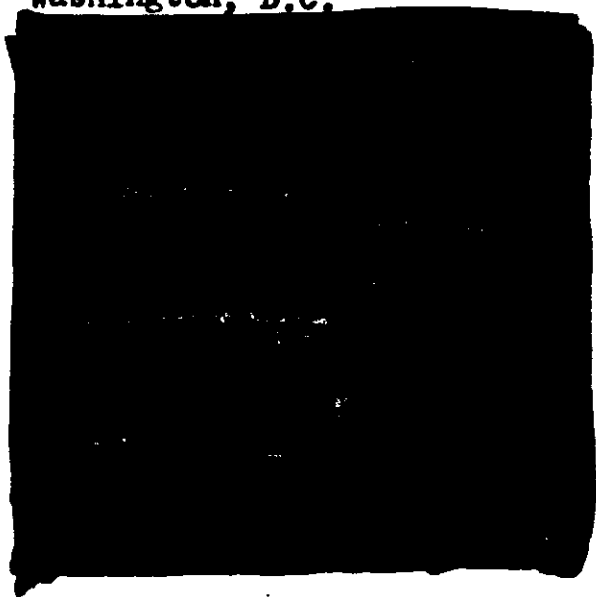

September 18, 1971 Session

[REDACTED] advised that the second session of the National MDC meeting was held on the evening of September 18, 1971. About 30-35 persons attended. The meeting was listless and dealt mainly with the new PCPJ scenarios for the fall actions. It was brought out that the local MDC groups were unable to function because of scanty funds and a lack of volunteers. It was announced that the State of New York had released the body of Sam Melville and that the body would be brought to the WSMC on September 19, 1971. The session adjourned at 10:35 p.m.

[REDACTED] furnished substantially the same information concerning the September 18, 1971 session. [REDACTED] stated that the MDC is without funds and would support the fall actions of the PCPJ because they do not have the financial ability to organize demonstrations on its own. [REDACTED] stated that Mike Drobenare mentioned that the MDC will attempt to hold a rock festival with the purpose of raising \$30,000.

[REDACTED] advised that it was determined that the MDC would not hold the "Heart Attack" demonstration on Wall Street, NYC, during November, 1971 because of apathy and lack of funds.

Sam Melville

Sam Melville was a convict at the New York State Penitentiary, Attica, NY. He was killed during the riots at that prison during September, 1971.

September 19, 1971 Session

On September 19, 1971, [REDACTED] advised that the scheduled third session of the National MDC meeting was not held. It was scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on September 19, 1971. Shortly after 2:00 p.m., the body of Sam Melville arrived at the WSMC. Because of the increased activities at the church in connection with the arrival of Melville's body and the general apathy displayed by those who had attended the first two sessions, the third session was not held.

According to the source, Mike Drobenare was overheard to state that the national meeting of the MDC was not successful and was poorly attended because it had been poorly organized and not enough people worked on it to make it a success. Drobenare stated that the MDC throughout the country is in a state of confusion but that there is still enough of the Mayday spirit alive that the MDC can be revived and rebuilt. Drobenare mentioned that the MDC will attempt to hold a fund raising rock concert at an undisclosed location on October 13, 1971, and that the MDC will use the PCPJ to obtain office space and funds. Drobenare stated that certain parts of the revised PCPJ scenario for the demonstrations in Washington, D.C. during October 25-29, 1971 are appealing and will be supported and expanded by the MDC. Drobenare opined that by participating in the PCPJ demonstrations contacts and plans can be made for local MDC actions.

On February 18, 1970, ABBIE HOFFMAN was found guilty in the USDC, NDI, Chicago, Illinois, of violating the Anti-Riot Law Statute for traveling in Interstate Commerce from outside the state of Illinois with the intent to incite a riot in Chicago, during the Democratic National Convention in August, 1968. On February 20, 1970, he was sentenced to five years imprisonment and fined \$5,000.00. On February 28, 1970, the United States Court of Appeals, Seventh Circuit, Chicago, ordered HOFFMAN released on \$25,000.00 bond pending an appeal of his conviction.

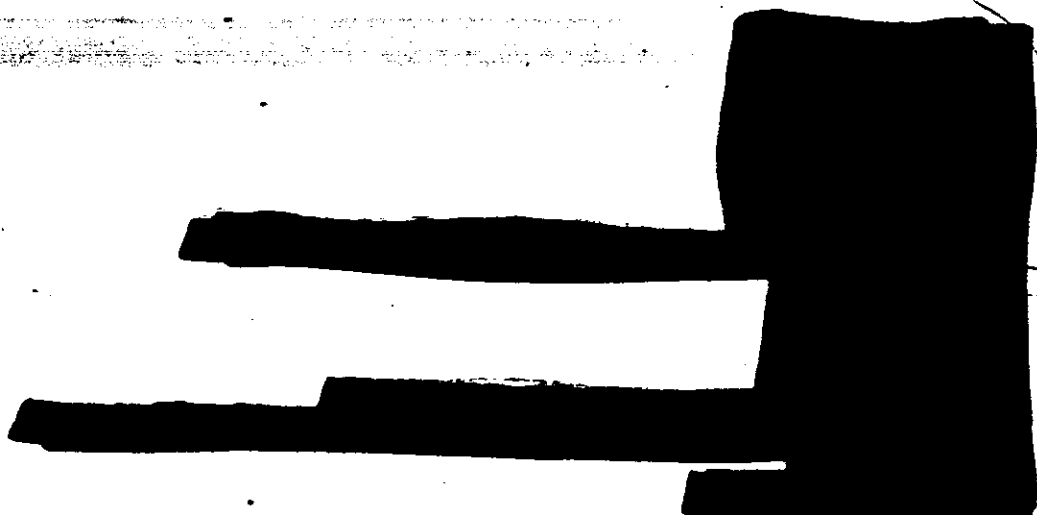

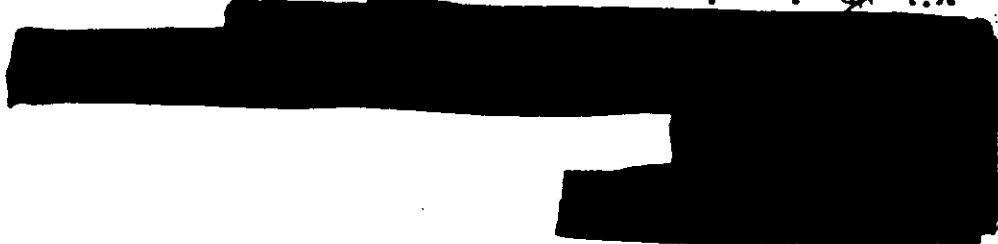

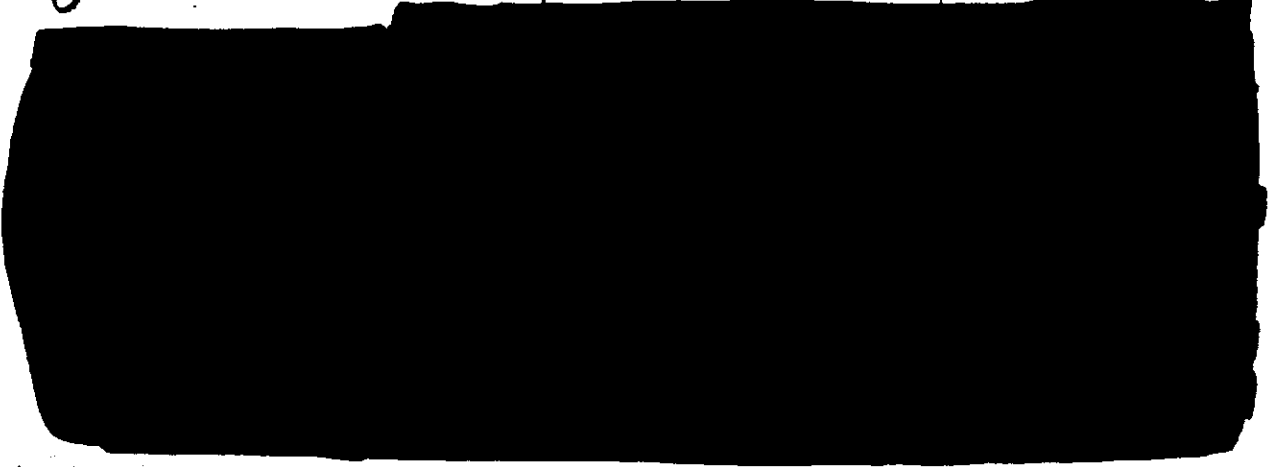
