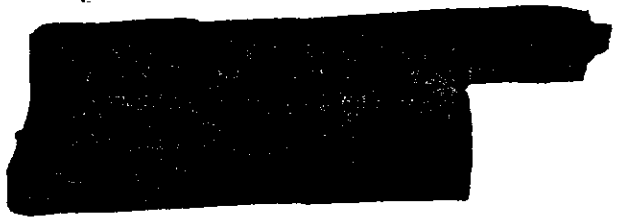



Since graduation from college in June, 1971 subject has spent most of his time in constant travel status between Washington, D.C. and New York; engaged in activities of the May Day Collective (MDC) and the Peoples Coalition for Peace and Justice (PCPJ). In January, 1972 he was appointed to the PCPJ Coordinating Committee. He has had some association with Hippie leaders, ABBA KATZ and ALBERT HARRIS.

He was involved with the Election Year Strategy Information Center (EYSIC), an organization formed during December, 1971, by the Chicago Seven member BERNIE DAVIS for the purpose of organizing New Left activities during the 1972 election year to culminate with demonstrations at the two major party conventions.



Subject was active with the Miami Convention Coalition during both the Democratic and Republican Conventions, was present in Flamingo Park but there are no reports of arrest or overt acts of disruption on his part.

To date there is no evidence that subject is a Marxist-Leninist revolutionary. He is opposed to war, racism and poverty and may develop into a revolutionary, but at the present time one would be hard put to state that he poses a realistic, direct and current danger to the national security. Sources have stated that subject deals in great rhetoric but his actions are frustrated by inept planning and indirection; therefore, while he might be willing to be an activist he at this time does not possess that capability.

It is not felt that the above conclusions are materially affected by the fact that subject was arrested 5/5/71 by the Metropolitan Police Department at the U.S. Capitol Plaza on a charge of unlawful entry. This arrest was dismissed by order of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia on 6/30/71. The relevance of this information is further diminished by the fact that it took place where hundreds of others were arrested for civil disobedience and related acts and since use of this information has been limited to internal security purposes within the FBI.

It is recommended subject be deleted from

ADEN.
