Also set out in this nitel was the fact that during 11/72 and 12/72, attempts to locate and interview DROBENARE in Buffalo resulted negatively. Also set out in the nitel was the fact that information obtained at 325 Jewett St., Buffalo, where DROBENARE was supposed to be living, determined that he was, in fact, not living at this address.

In consideration of the above, it is obvious that DROBENARE has been in a constant travel status. Buffalo notes New York's comments in referenced New York airtel of 6/21/73 that Miami is in receipt of all pertinent background data concerning DROBENARE and his possible involvement in PENBOM. Buffalo also notes in referenced Miami airtel of 6/21/73 that DROBENARE is presently in New York City in the lead for New York to locate DROBENARE regarding his possible involvement in PENBOM.

Buffalo is continuing its efforts to locate and interview MARTIN FEINRIDER regarding his possible involvement in PENBOM.

A female answered the phone and then she put MICHAEL ALAN DROBENARE on the telephone. When DROBENARE was advised that the FBI would like to speak with him, he became belligerent, inquiring if the FBI had a warrant for his arrest and if not to leave him alone.

However, the agent calling was able to calm DROBENARE and he consented to speak over the phone but was not receptive to a personal interview as he feels he has nothing to hide and no interest in being in the company of any FBI agent.

The contents of DROBENARE's interview are contained in attached PD-302.

On July 13, 1973, a telephone call to LEO DROBENARE (father of MICHAEL ALAN DROBENARE) to confirm the July 14, 1973 arrival of MICHAEL in New York City resulted in MICHAEL ALAN DROBENARE answering the telephone.

MICHAEL DROBENARE was advised of Special Agent [REDACTED] identity and the reason for the interview.

DROBENARE advised that if the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) had no warrant for his arrest, they should leave him and his parents alone.

After a few moments of preliminary conversation, DROBENARE agreed to speak with the FBI over the telephone but expressed no desire to meet with or be seen with any FBI agent in person.

DROBENARE advised that he was in Washington, D.C. when the Pentagon bombing occurred, but he heard about it over the radio and had nothing to do with any bombing.

DROBENARE advised he was working with DAVID DELLINGER and other anti-war people on posters, lighting, stages and other activities in conjunction with the May Day demonstrations.

DROBENARE advised that the people he was working with had no inclination towards violence such as bombing.

DROBENARE indicated that he was pleased to have been involved in the anti-war movement, which he felt had made a significant mark on the American people, despite the fact that the anti-war movement was currently dead.

DROBENARE advised he had nothing to do with the Pentagon bombing, despite the fact that he does not remember exactly where he was in Washington, D.C. on May 18, 19, 1972.

When questioned about JOE DANGERT's possible involvement, DROBENARE laughed, exclaiming that that "Crazy Guy" would have probably blown up himself along with the Pentagon if he had been responsible for the Pentagon bombing.

DROBENARE advised he has a lawyer if he needs one, but he is not worrying about anything except his father (recently injured) and aiding his father with the operation of the family business.

DROBENARE advised he has nothing to hide or fear from his past anti-war activities, and the interview was terminated..

If New York is in possession of additional information which would justify Drobrenare's removal from the suspect list, promptly advise. Otherwise, investigation should continue in an effort to either prove or disprove Drobrenare's participation in or knowledge of Penbom.
