Her current employment is unknown. Subject's activities in the YIP during November, 1969-November, 1970, set forth. Subject was observed in WDC, 11/14-15/70, during anti-war demonstrations in that city, attended Black Panther Party's Revolutionary People's Constitutional Convention, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, 9/5/70, spoke at demonstration in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 9/26/70, sponsored by Revolutionary Youth Movement and YIP-White Panther Party and appeared at bail reduction hearing of JUDY CLARK, NYC, 12/22/70.

During June, 1968, subject indicated she had attended the University of Toronto, Toronto, Canada, during 1961-1968. She received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in 1965, a Master of Arts Degree in 1966, and had studied for a Doctorate Degree during 1966-1968. Her field of study was Sociology.

C. Employment

During June, 1968, subject indicated she had been employed as a Teaching Assistant at the University of Toronto during 1966-1968, and as a Lecturer at the University of Toronto in the Sociology Department from May, 1967 to August, 1967, and as a Teaching Associate at the University of California, Berkeley, California, during April-June, 1968.

During July-November, 1970, the subject was a leader of the Youth International Party (YIP), NYC. Her current employment is unknown.

The YIP is publicly known as an organization that was founded in January, 1968, in NYC, with the announced intention of promoting a fun and games Youth Festival of Life demonstration at the National Democratic Convention in Chicago, Illinois, in August, 1968.

D. Residence

Subject resided at 5 St. Marks Place, NYC, during October, 1970.

Subject moved from NYC to Boston, Massachusetts, during November, 1970, and currently resides in the Boston area. The address in the Boston area is not known.

II. AFFILIATION WITH THE YIP

The "Los Angeles Free Press", a Los Angeles, California publication, issue of December, 1969-January, 1970, pages 2 and 3, contains a news story captioned, "The YIP Myth Becomes a Reality" by the Liberation News Service (LNS), NYC. This news story reports that JUDY GUMBO attended a meeting held at the Underground Press Syndicate (UPS) Loft, NYC, on December 6-7, 1969, for the purpose of reorganizing the YIP.

A characterization of the LNS appears in the Appendix Section of this report.

The subject is widely known as JUDY GUMBO.

The "New York Post", a daily newspaper published in NYC, edition of September 22, 1970, page 4, contains a news story with a dateline of "Washington", captioned, "Anti-War Groups Plan Ky Greeting". The news story reports on plans by anti-war groups to demonstrate in Washington, D. C. (WDC), on October 3, 1970, in the event Vice President NGUYEN CAO KY of South Vietnam appears at a pro-Vietnam War rally in WDC on that date. The news story reports in part as follows:

"The Youth International Party has become the first New Left organization to declare open warfare on South Vietnam's controversial Vice President Nguyen Cao Ky, for agreement to address a pro-war rally here next month.

"The stated purpose of Ky's invitation to Washington is to address a "March to Victory" rally that will be held at the base of the Washington Monument. The rally is being organized by right wing Fundamentalist radio preacher, Carl Mc Intire.


"Mc Intire predicted that his rally would attract 500,000 people. Now, however, District of Columbia security officials and police are beginning to fear that a large percentage of that group will be protesters, not sympathizers.

"This anxiety was heightened yesterday by a YIP spokesman who told reporters at a news conference here 'we declare the rally to be a free-fire zone'.

"The spokesman, Judy Gumbo, who took part in the Chicago demonstrations, declined to go into any details about what weapons might be used in the 'free-fire' zone.

"She promised that her group, among others, would try to disrupt the rally.

"Miss Gumbo said that her party regards Ky, who once said he admired Hitler for his organizational abilities as an 'incredible pig'. She went on to describe Ky as a 'total fascist....responsible for incredible murders, tortures, and hangings'.

Subject and JERRY RUBIN held a press conference at the YIP Office, NYC, on October 6, 1970. The purpose of the conference was to present a report from the Weatherman Underground by BERNARDINE DOHRN. JENNIFER DOHRN, sister of BERNARDINE DOHRN, certified that the press release was in the handwriting of BERNARDINE DOHRN and the voice on a recording of the release was the voice of BERNARDINE DOHRN.

JERRY CLYDE RUBIN was found guilty on February 18, 1970, in the United States (US) District Court, Northern District of Illinois, for violation of the Federal Anti-Riot Laws, arising out of rioting that occurred in Chicago, Illinois, during the National Democratic Convention during August, 1968. RUBIN was sentenced to 5 years imprisonment and fined \$5,000. He has been released on \$25,000 bond pending appeal.

BERNARDINE DOHRN is publicly known as a member of the Weatherman faction of the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS). On April 2, 1970, she was indicted by a Federal Grand Jury (FGJ), Chicago, Illinois, for violation of the Federal Anti-Riot Laws in connection with her participation in demonstrations in Chicago during October, 1969, to protest the War in Vietnam and the trial of the "Chicago 7" Anti-Riot Law defendants. On July 23, 1970, she was indicted in the US District Court, Eastern District of Michigan, for conspiracy to transfer explosives in interstate commerce with the intention to injure persons or destroy or damage buildings.

STEWART ALBERT was arrested on April 12, 1966, at Berkeley, California, along with other members of the Progressive Labor Party (PLP), at a demonstration in front of the Berkeley City Hall.

The Committee to Defend the Panther 21 is publicly known as an organization founded to aid members of the Black Panther Party (BPP), some of whom were arrested in NYC on April 2, 1969, on charges of Conspiracy to Commit Arson and Murder.

A characterization of the BPP appears in the Appendix of this report.

On February 18, 1970, ABBOTT HOFFMAN was found guilty of conspiracy in the Northern District of Illinois, Chicago, Illinois, for violation of the Federal Anti-Riot Laws, arising out of rioting in Chicago, Illinois, during the Democratic National Convention in August, 1968. On February 18, 1970, he was sentenced to 5 years imprisonment and fined \$5,000. On February 20, 1970, the US Court of Appeals, Chicago, ordered a \$25,000 bail pending appeal.

It was learned that a demonstration was scheduled by the YIP and other groups at the United Nations on October 23, 1970, protesting the visit of President Nixon to the UN. It was also learned that there had been attempts to recruit the Gay Liberation Front (GLF) of NYC to participate in the activities and to have the GLF members undress and parade in the nude in order to mark public for the purpose of degrading the President.

Subject attended a YIP press conference at the NYC Women's House of Detention, Greenwich Street and 6th Avenue, NYC, on October 20, 1970. The conference was held to announce that TIMOTHY LEARY is living in Algeria and to announce the YIP Fall Offensive, beginning with a "YIP-In" in Central Park, NYC, on October 24, 1970. The subject announced that the conference was held at the Women's House of Detention to show YIP support for ANGELA DAVIS, who was at that time incarcerated in that prison.

TIMOTHY LEARY is publicly known as an escapee from a California prison following his conviction on armed robbery. LEARY appeared in Algeria in 1967.

ANGELA DAVIS is publicly known as a self-admitted member of the Communist Party (CP) and is charged with murder, kidnapping, and conspiracy in San Rafael, California.

The subject attended a rally held in the Sheep Meadow of Central Park, NYC, on October 3, 1969. The affair consisted of a speech by the speaker and a softball game.

III. MISCELLANEOUS ACTIVITIES

Subject was observed in WDC, November 14-15, 1969, during the anti-Vietnam war demonstrations in that city at that time.

Present at a Women's Union Meeting, July 13, 1970, at St. Gregory's Church, 144 West 90th St., NYC, and the Gay Cafe Storefront, 235 Columbus Avenue, NYC, was JUDY GUMBA. This individual and a second woman spoke about their recent trip to North Vietnam. Two and a third woman had been elected as representatives of the Women's Liberation Movement. GUMBA is active in several National Liberation Front women's groups. Most of the information furnished by GUMBA was specifically concerned with women's liberation. She stated that the North Vietnamese would like to receive letters from women in the US. The two women will to write to the North Vietnamese Generalissimo Generalissimo Generalissimo Generalissimo Le Roi, Paris, France.

Subject attended the BPP's Revolutionary People's Constitutional Convention in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (Pa.), on September 5, 1970.

Subject attended and spoke at a demonstration held on the campus of Marquette University, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on September 26, 1970. The demonstration was sponsored in part by the Revolutionary Youth Movement and the YIP-White Panther Party. The demonstration consisted of guerrilla theater and speeches. Subject was introduced as a leader of the YIP. She spoke about North Vietnam and in her remarks, she had complete praise for that country. She announced that a demonstration would be held in NYC on the weekend of October 3, 1970 and she urged everyone present at the demonstration to participate. Subject indicated she had to be careful in her remarks because she could be prosecuted if she said "anything wrong".

A characterization of the Revolutionary Youth Movement appears in the Appendix of this report.

Rubin is publicly known as one of the founders of the Youth International Party (YIP) in New York City, in early 1968. Rubin, a member of a group called "Chicago 7," was arrested and sentenced under Federal Anti-Riot Laws for his participation in violent protest activities which occurred during the Democratic National Convention, in August of 1968, at Chicago, Illinois. Rubin is currently free from jail after having posted bond.

Judith Lee Hemblen

Hemblen, who lives with YIP leader Jerry Clyde Rubin, is publicly known as a YIP activist.

A second source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, on February 16, 1971, advised that the White Panther Party (WPP) was formed in Detroit, Michigan, during December of 1968, and originally endorsed the 10-point program of the Black Panther Party (BPP) and advocated social and cultural reform. VENCEREMOS BRIGADE (VB)

The Venceremos Brigade (VB) has been publicly described as a group of American volunteers travelling to Cuba, at the invitation of the Cuban Government, to assist in the harvesting of sugar cane.

The VB, organized in June 1969 by a coalition of the "New Left" in open defiance of the United States Department of State ban on travel to Cuba, has already sponsored two contingents to Cuba. One group of over 200 Americans travelled to Cuba via Mexico in November - December 1969 for a stay of almost two months. The second group of over 500 Americans departed by Cuban vessel at St. John's, New Brunswick, Canada, on February 13, 1970, and returned on April 28, 1970.

"Venceremos," translated, means "we will win," a slogan of the late CHE GUEVERA, Cuban revolutionary leader.

WEATHERMAN

Initially called the "Action Faction," Weatherman came into being immediately before the June, 1969, Students for a Democratic Society (SDS) National Convention (NC). At this NC Weatherman won all three national officer positions and a majority of the National Interim Committee as well. Subsequently, they took over the SDS National Office (NO) in Chicago, and controlled its funds, paper and national records. Although internal struggle existed until late 1969, Weatherman for all major purposes controlled SDS nationally from June, 1969, until its NO closed in February, 1970. At this time it no longer considered itself part of SDS.

The term Weatherman emerged from an ideological paper prepared by its leaders entitled "You Don't Need a Weatherman to Know Which Way the Wind Blows" ("New Left Notes" June 18, 1969). This statement outlined the basic stance of Weatherman: Marxist-Leninist in content but with strong advocacy that action not theory would bring about revolution in the United States. This posture was complemented with an international identification to the Cuban revolution and Castro's statement that the duty of a revolutionary is to make revolution.

During October, 1969, Weatherman riots in Chicago resulted in more than 260 arrests for mob action and related charges. A program of armed struggle was finalized during a December, 1969, "War Council" wherein terrorist tactics and political assassination were contemplated. The basic strength of Weatherman was then revealed to be some 300 - 350 nationally and geographically apportioned to the Midwest, New York, and some Northwest.

As its rhetoric of violence escalated, Weatherman leaders increasingly discussed the necessity of an underground operation wherein more than 90 percent of the organization would be submerged; "affinity groups" of three - five members would function independently. In February, 1970, Weatherman leaders announced a program of "strategic sabotage" with police and military installations as primary targets.

In February, 1970, Weatherman abandoned the SDS NO, 1608 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, and throughout the country entered an underground status.

WORKER STUDENT ALLIANCE/PROGRESSIVE LABOR PARTY

A source advised during August, 1969, that at the National Convention (NC) of Students for a Democratic Society (SDS) held in Chicago, Illinois, during June, 1969, a split arose between the Progressive Labor Party (PLP) and the National Office (NO), the NO becoming known as the Weatherman faction. The PLP faction drew the largest support among those in attendance at the NC.

Source further advised that during late summer, 1969, the PLP faction of SDS established its National Headquarters (NH) on the second floor of a loft-type building at 173A Massachusetts Avenue, Boston, Massachusetts. The campaign on which the PLP faction centered was to build a worker student alliance or a campus worker student alliance. Thus, they adopted the names of Worker Student Alliance (WSA) or Campus Worker Student Alliance.

Source stated that the "New Left Notes," printed in New York City, is the official publication of the WSA faction.

A second source advised during January, 1970, that within the SDS, the WSA is a caucus of which the PLP constitutes the leadership.

A third source advised during July, 1970, that during demonstrations staged in the Boston area during the Spring and Summer of 1970 by the NH, the main theme of previous demonstrations staged by the NH shifted from protestations of the Vietnam War and other United States foreign policy matters to attacking domestic issues such as racism and unemployment and demonstrating support of the "Workers' struggle."

JERRY RUBIN is the self-professed founder of the Youth International Party (YIP) in early 1968. RUBIN was one of eight persons indicted by the Federal Grand Jury, Northern District of Illinois (NDI), Chicago, Illinois, March, 1969, regarding Anti-Riot Law violations in conjunction with his activities during the Democratic National Convention, Chicago, Illinois, in August, 1968. On February 18, 1970, RUBIN was found guilty in the United States District Court (USDC), NDI, for violating the Anti-Riot Law statute in that he did travel in interstate commerce from outside the State of Illinois to Chicago, Illinois with intent to incite, organize, promote, and encourage a riot on or about August 26, 1968, and August 27, 1968. On February 20, 1970, RUBIN was sentenced to five years imprisonment and fined \$5000 plus payment of court costs. As a result of the trial, RUBIN was found guilty on February 15, 1970, of fifteen separate contempt citations and was sentenced to a combined total of 25 months and 23 days imprisonment. On February 28, 1970, the United States Court of Appeals, 7th District

Circuit, Chicago, Illinois, ordered that RUBIN
be released on \$25,000 bond.

The YIP may be characterized as an organization founded in January, 1968, in New York City with publicly announced intention of promoting a fun and games Youth Festival of Life Demonstration at the August, 1968, Democratic National Convention. YIPPIE contingents publicly were identified as prominent among those involved in Chicago demonstrations during August, 1968.

A characterization of the Weatherman Faction of SDS is contained in the appendix of this report.

An interview was undertaken at Apartment 2 Albermarle Court, Boston, Massachusetts, where, according to the lobby mailbox, the occupants' names were listed as follows: "CLAVIR, FEINBERG, GUMBO."

Agents knocked on the above apartment door and, upon identifying themselves as being with the FBI, were told by a female voice to go away. Agents requested to talk with JUDITH CLAVIR and subsequently, the female speaking stated that she was the person whom the agents sought to speak with. She stated she had nothing to say to the FBI and that if any information was sought from her it should be done through her lawyer whom she identified as BILL SCHAAP, 103 Park Avenue, New York City. She stated she had no local lawyer in the Boston area but she was aware of her rights and the fact that she did not have to talk to FBI agents.

CLAVIR stated there was nothing wrong, in her opinion, with her immigrant status in the United States. She stated she was not then in possession of her Alien Registration Card.

CLAVIR, still refusing to open the door, commented that she was aware of the reward of \$100,000 offered in connection with the bombing of the United States Capitol but stated that she knew nothing about it.

Upon being further questioned regarding her identity, she stated from behind the closed door that she was "Miss CLAVIR." When asked where her husband was, she answered, "I've had 1,000 husbands." She further commented that she had been to Moscow, Russia, and hated the country and its officials. She made no comment to a question as to whether she had ever been to Cuba.

CLAVIR refused to identify the individuals present in the apartment with her. She stated they were all women, although it was evident from voices within that at least two males were present.

b. Public Appearances and Speeches

The Washington Post, a Washington D.C. daily newspaper, in issue dated May 26, 1971, carried an article captioned "YIPPIES, Witch Dig Bombing of the Capital" which pertained to a news conference held by JUDY GUMBO on May 25, 1971. The article in part described JUDY GUMBO as stating that they were being framed by the Government for an act committed by members of the Weatherman underground (Weatherman Faction of SDS). She was quoted "We didn't do it, but we dug it".

This article also revealed JUDY GUMBO would refuse to testify before a Federal Grand Jury in New York City which she had been subject to appear before.

Weatherman, formerly a faction of Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), controlled the SDS National Office from June, 1969, until its closing in February, 1970. Weatherman then entered an underground status and adopted a tactic of "strategic sabotage," with police and military installations designated as primary targets.

Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), was founded during June, 1962, at Port Huron, Michigan, and in the 1960's functioned as the leading New Left campus-based student organization in the United States. From a stance of "participatory democracy," the SDS moved to a radical-revolutionary position. It maintained a national office at 1608 West Madison Street, Chicago Illinois, until February, 1970. Internal factionalism during 1969 produced three main factions: Weatherman, Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM), and Worker Student Alliance (WSA). The Weatherman and RYM no longer consider themselves associated with the SDS. The WSA faction continues to use the name SDS.

Similar articles appeared in the Boston Herald Traveler on June 4, 1971, and in the Boston Globe on June 3, 1971. Both are Boston, Massachusetts daily newspapers.

The Boston Globe mentioned above in issue dated June 8, 1971, carried an article entitled "Electric 5 Assail Probe of New York Bank Bombing", which pertained to another news conference held by JUDY GUMBO on June 7, 1971. In this article, GUMBO alleged the inquiry by the Federal Grand Jury is an attempt to implicate her in the bombing of the U.S. Capital in March, 1971.

This article was also carried in the Boston Herald Traveler and the Boston Record American, both Boston, Massachusetts daily newspapers.

II ACTIVITIES

a. Suspicion of Bombing

JUDY GUMBO was served a subpoena on May 22, 1971 in front of her residence, 2 Albemarle Court, Boston, Massachusetts. The subpoena ordered her to appear before a Federal Grand Jury, in Foley Square Courthouse, New York City, on May 27, 1971. A meeting of the New York May Day Collective of groups and individuals who had participated in the demonstrations in Washington, D.C. on April 30, 1971 and in New York City on May 1, 1971, took place at 111 West 11th Street, New York City, on May 27, 1971.

At this meeting, it was learned by individuals attending that JUDY GUMBO had been served a subpoena to appear before a Federal Grand Jury in the Southern District of New York concerning the attempted fire bombing of the First National City Bank, 91st Street and Madison Avenue, New York City, on December 4, 1970, and refused to testify.

The New York May Day Collective agreed to support a demonstration at Foley Square, New York City on June 8, 1971 when JUDY GUMBO and others are scheduled to appear before the Federal Grand Jury.

A meeting for the Family Trust Defense Committee (FTDC), an organization located in New York City, to raise funds for the defense of individuals arrested in New York City Department of Social Services, charges of welfare fraud, the New York State Bar Association, New York City Bar Association, and the New York City Bar Association. It was learned that the FTDC had a New York May Day Collection and a sponsor of a demonstration at Foley Square, New York City, on May 1, 1971, and that GUMBO and thus appearing before the Federal Grand Jury.

An interview with JUDITH LEE HEMBLEN, also known as JUDITH LEE CLAVIR, JUDY GUMBO, was attempted at Apartment 3, 2 Albermarle Court, Boston. A female, whose voice sounded like HEMBLEN, after being advised that FBI Agents wanted to talk to her, stated that she did not want to talk to them and that they should go away. At the same time as she answered, she snapped an inside lock in place.

Agents requested her to open the door and talk to them but she refused to do so and repeated the suggestion that they go away.

At this point, the attempted interview was terminated.

Because existing information logically points to those previously named, it is considered essential to exhaust every effort to determine whether they were, in fact, perpetrators of the bombing. Lacking physical evidence from which to proceed, it is necessary to conduct extensive and complete investigation of these suspects prior to and subsequent to the bombing to try to resolve the matter. Bearing in mind the parallel existing security investigations being conducted, it is believed desirable that investigation hereinafter detailed be handled by the case agent assigned to the security subject involved to eliminate overlap and unnecessary duplication of effort. This, of course, will require the case agent to thoroughly familiarize himself with Capbom and suspected role of his subject. Any additional information in this regard needed by auxiliary offices in the Capbom case may be obtained from office of origin, WFO.

A complete and in-depth review of all information in your files concerning these individual subjects is to be made by the office of origin. A similar review of all information in Bureau files concerning these individual subjects is being accomplished.

Intensification of the investigations on these individual subjects should include, but not be limited to, development of the following concerning Capbom:

1. Information which would prove or disprove individual's participation in or knowledge of Capbom.
2. Information which would facilitate targeting an informant against the individual.
3. Information pointing toward a solid penetrating interview of individual under secure conditions.

In connection with your review of all information in your files relating to the individual subjects and subsequent investigation, the following information, which is not all inclusive, should be obtained:

1. Whereabouts of the individual for six months prior to the bombing.

The "Washington Post," a Washington, D. C., daily newspaper in issue dated 5/26/71, carried an article captioned

"YIPPIES, Witch Dig Bombing of the Capital," which pertained to a news conference held by HEMBLEN on 5/25/71. The article in part described HEMBLEN as stating that they were being framed by the Government for an act committed by members of the Weatherman underground (Weatherman faction of SDS). She was quoted "We didn't do it, but we dug it."

This article also revealed HEMBLEN would refuse to testify before a Federal Grand Jury in New York City which she had been subject to appear before.

Similar articles appeared in the "Boston Herald Traveler" on 6/4/71 and in the "Boston Globe" on 6/3/71. Both are Boston, Massachusetts, daily newspapers.

The "Boston Globe" mentioned above in issue dated 6/3/71 carried an article entitled "Electric 5 Assault Probe of New York Bank Bombing," which pertained to another news conference held by HEMBLEN on 6/7/71. In this article, HEMBLEN alleged the inquiry by the Federal Grand Jury is an attempt to implicate her in the bombing of the U. S. Capitol in March, 1971.

This article was also carried in the "Boston Herald Traveler" and the "Boston Record American," both Boston, Massachusetts, daily newspapers.





Although the Bureau's extensive investigation of the bombing of the U.S. Capitol 3/1/71 has developed suspects and Federal Grand Jury action is pending concerning some of them, the importance of this case dictates that we continue to press and expand our investigation in an effort to develop additional information of value. The time lapse, nature of crime, and revolutionary proclivities of likely subjects make it absolutely imperative we drive hard toward an early solution. The most logical suspects at present are New Left activists with recidivist tendencies—the longer they remain free, the more encouraged and bold they might be to perpetrate other similar crimes. Implementation of following instructions will hopefully bring the desired results. These instructions do not alter but augment those in Bureau airtel 10/7/71 to offices of origin concerning eight suspects. All offices are being apprised of this situation and of Bureau's instructions relating to CAPBOM and the related suspect cases so they may adequately handle all leads which may develop.

Captions, Copy Adequacy and Nature of Correspondence

Henceforth all correspondence relating to the investigation of any of these subjects (excluded are purely administrative communications such as FD-122 and FD-123 relating to AUSA status) should bear dual captions, CAPCOM, followed by individual case caption as in above list. If more than one suspect is mentioned, show individual captions for each following the main CAPCOM caption. Include sufficient copies for Bureau's file on CAPCOM and each suspect in caption. Provide also for sufficient copies for field office files (WFO as origin for CAPCOM and the indicated origin for the suspect). All correspondence relating to CAPCOM and suspects shall be by teletype or airtel depending upon urgency of contents and verifiability of leads. This does not, of course, exclude use of telephone when circumstances so indicate.

Urgency of Investigation

All leads, whether relating to CAPCOM or individual suspects, are to be assigned immediately and accorded continuous investigative attention. Sufficient personnel must be assigned to fulfill these responsibilities and they are held personally accountable for insubordinating these and the other instructions herein.

Scope of Investigation

While the following pertains primarily to WFO and other offices of origin, note should be taken also by all auxiliary offices for their guidance and to better understand Bureau's current immediate objectives. In view of the subversive backgrounds of the suspects, Bureau desires to intensify the current approach to CAPCOM which is of a security/intelligence orientation. Required is all possible information relating to suspects' whereabouts, not only for six months prior to the bombing, but future whereabouts on as near a day-to-day basis as is feasible; associations; interrelated contacts by the suspects for a period of six months prior to bombing; finances; depth of current subversive involvement; indications of defection or withdrawal from previously held subversive views; character defects and exploitability of same; and vulnerability to penetration by informants or associates whom we may target against them. In short, an in depth analytical character study of each suspect is required. In furthering our aims, it is intended that no logical investigative step be excluded. Give

serious consideration to use of all logical investigative avenues such as those normally used in intelligence and security type investigations, the intensive interrogation of suspects and others under appropriately planned and controlled conditions, to name a few. Even in this case even though we may pursue these investigations in a security/surveillance context and even though we may consider use of all types of investigative techniques, we must not overlook the necessity for securing admissible evidence for use in achieving our ultimate objective--successful criminal prosecution. Of course, if it is normally required that burden of proof be secured in advance of the use of a particular investigative technique, such Bureau authority will also be required in these cases.

It shall be incumbent upon the office of origin concerning the suspects to fully analyze the information as developed by all offices and to promptly set out leads and follow their coverage. Origin is to also make appropriate recommendations to target informants against the suspects. Better effort should also include consideration being given to develop in Bureau informants those associated with areas to have the potential for informant development, with ultimate goal of targeting against the suspect.

Current Canvas of Informants

It will be recalled that at the outset of the CAPBOM investigation all offices were instructed to canvas all informants (security, racial, criminal) for possible information concerning the bombing and perpetrators thereof. It is now desired that all offices canvas informants in the security field, particularly those is Adiegeable of New Left and related activities, for information concerning the eight suspects. No need to relate to informants possible connection with CAPBOM. Purpose of this canvas is to assist in obtaining all reasonable new information concerning the suspects as part of the character study detailed above. This instruction should be given prompt attention and no later than 30 days from above date all offices should submit an airtel to the Bureau and KFO in the CAPBOM caption identifying all informants and dates contacted and including results of contacts. In every instance that positive information is obtained, the airtel should contain additional caption covering the suspect reported on and copy designated for office of origin.
