One copy of instant report is provided the INS, NYC, because subject is a Canadian alien.

The representative of the INS, NYC, who furnished information on 1/19/71 is Agent [redacted] who telephonically advised SA [redacted] stated that the subject continues to be subject of an INS "Exclusion Proceedings" investigation and that a request has been made of the Regional Director of the INS by the INS Office in NYC to hold an "Exclusion Hearing" on subject with respect to subject's travel to Cuba in August, 1970.

[redacted] also advised that the INS, NYC, has not received a notification of subject's address by INS Form I-53 which aliens are required to file with the INS each January. According to [redacted] even if subject did execute Form I-53 during January, 1972, it will not be on file with the INS, NYC for a couple of months. [redacted] stated that he will keep the NYO apprised of pertinent developments in the INS investigation of subject.





It is noted that subject's maiden name is CLAVIR.

Weatherman

Weatherman, formerly a faction of Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), controlled the SDS National Office from June, 1969 until its closing in February, 1970. Weatherman then entered an underground status

and adopted a tactic of "strategic sabotage," with police and military installations designated as primary targets.

SDS

SDS was founded during June, 1962 at Port Huron, Michigan and in the 1960's functioned as the leading New Left campus-based student organization in the US. From a stance of "participatory democracy," the SDS moved to a radical-revolutionary position. It maintained a national office at 1608 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, until February, 1970. Internal factionalism during 1969 produced three main factions: Weatherman, Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM) and Worker Student Alliance (WSA). The Weatherman and RYM no longer consider themselves associated with the SDS. The WSA faction continues to use the name SDS.

[REDACTED] subject was overheard to state that she was attempting to turn the Youth International Party (YIP) in Boston, Massachusetts into a women's collective but had not been too successful.

YIP

The YIP, also known as Yippies, is a loosely-knit, anti-establishment, revolutionary youth organization formed in NYC in January, 1968.

The May Day Collective (MDC) of NYC planned a demonstration at Rockefeller Center, NYC, on July 6, 1971. The purpose of the demonstration was to protest the war in Vietnam to the defense oriented corporations with offices located in Rockefeller Center, the welfare cuts in NYC, rent decontrol and the "grand inquisition," that is, the use of Grand Juries to investigate matters in Seattle, Washington, NYC, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania and other localities.

MDC

The MDC in NYC is publicly known as an organization that participated in demonstrations in Washington, D.C. during first week of May, 1971 sponsored by the Peoples Coalition for Peace and Justice (PCPJ). The MDC in NYC has been inactive since September, 1971.

PCPJ

The PCPJ is self-described as an organization consisting of over 100 organizations using massive civil disobedience to combat war, racism, poverty and repression. Its National Office is located at 156 5th Avenue, NYC, Room 527.

Subject was observed participating in the demonstration at Rockefeller, NYC, on July 6, 1971. Subject gave a short speech at the corner of West 50th Street and Rockefeller Plaza on the evils of the Grand Jury system of investigation. She mentioned being "hassled" over the bombing of the Capitol in Washington, D.C. and stated that she and others had absolutely nothing to do with the Capitol bombing and that the Weatherman people had announced that they were responsible for the Capitol bombing. Subject also spoke briefly on the benefits of the Women's Liberation Movement (WLM).

SAS of the FBI  
July 6, 1971

Source advised that a demonstration was planned at the NYC office of Governor NELSON ROCKEFELLER located at 22 West 55th Street, NYC, on September 20, 1971 to protest the "massacre" at the Attica Correctional Facility, Attica, New York (NY).

Subject was observed among the demonstrators at 22 West 55th Street, NYC, on September 20, 1971 between 4:51 p.m. and 5:25 p.m. Banners carried by demonstrators indicated the sponsors of the demonstration to be the Madame Binh Brigade (MBB) and the Prisoners Solidarity Committee (PSC).

SA of the FBI

MBB

The MBB is a group of women organized around the GEORGE JACKSON slaying in a California prison and the Attica Prison riot. Their actions revolve around a general prison reform theme.

PSC

The PSC is a front group of the Workers World Party (WWP).

WWP

The WWP was founded in 1959 by individuals who disagreed with policies of the Socialist Workers Party (SWP). The WWP dissidents advocated unconditional support of the Soviet Union and the building of a revolutionary party geared to the overthrow of capitalism. More recently the WWP has called for peaceful solutions to Sino-Soviet disputes, however, the WWP generally supports the People's Republic of China in its ideological differences with the Soviet Union.

The SWP has been designated pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

A demonstration protesting the "massacre" at the Attica Correctional Facility was held at East 23rd Street and Lexington Avenue, NYC, on October 6, 1971. One of the sponsors of the demonstration was the Young Lords Party (YLP).




Take no corrective action with Secret Service and INS, to whom referenced report was disseminated locally, unless substance is affected in which event you must follow provisions in Manual of Rules and Regulations.

On Page 8 subject is referred to as a "Canadian alien." This reference to subject is repeated in line 1 of the synopsis. While subject is an alien in the U. S., she is a Canadian citizen. Bureau copies have been corrected to change "alien" to "citizen." Recipients take like action.

On Page D appears the cautionary statement "WARNING FOR EXTREMISTS." This is repeated in the synopsis and on Page 10. Bureau is obviously not issuing warnings for extremists. Bureau copies have been corrected to change "FOR" to read "RE." Recipients correct your copies.

Typographical errors as follows in the FD-305 have been corrected and recipients should take like action. Under Item #6, penultimate line, "effect" should read "affect." Under Item #10, "Algeria" was misspelled. Also, under Item 10, reference is made to "Item #10." It should have referred to #9.

It is stated on the FD-305 that subject had traveled to Hanoi, North Vietnam. Please advise Bureau of identity of communication reporting such travel as verified.

On Page 2 information in the first paragraph is attributed to a "Representative," INS, NYC. Bureau does not discern any reason for not reporting identity of INS employee. Unless you can justify not reporting identity, furnish same so it may be added to report in replacement for "Representative." Include individual's position.

It is reported on Page 2 that subject resides with [redacted]. This is followed by an indented characterization of [redacted] reporting that she had been indicted on a Federal charge and is free on bond pending trial. This is not a desirable characterization. What is called for is a very succinct statement containing subversive information concerning [redacted]. Considerable such information about her is available to your office. While corrective action is not being asked for in this instance, foregoing is for your future guidance.

The characterization of [redacted] on Page 3 is similarly undesirable. If [redacted] merits mention in the report, he should be characterized by the use of subversive information concerning him. Merely mentioning that he was an attorney for certain convicted defendants and that he was sentenced for contempt in connection with the trial of those defendants is undesirable. There is nothing subversive, per se, about such legal activities and the contempt citation. By return airtel previously referred to, submit revised page 3.

Give foregoing matters expedite attention as dissemination is being held in abeyance.

Your office has been previously advised concerning the importance of the Hemblen investigation. A further review of case file on HEMBLEN disclose the following concerning her whereabouts in August, 1971:

As of 8/4/71, subject periodically received mail at Apt. 3, 2 Albermarle Court, Boston, Massachusetts.

It was learned on 8/12/71 that all the occupants of Apt. 3, 2 Albermarle Court, Boston, Massachusetts had vacated that premises without leaving a forwarding address.

It was determined on 8/16/71 that subject had moved from Boston to NYC and could be reached through Attorney BILL

[redacted] stated that according to his [redacted] the apartment has apparently been occupied during December, 1971 and January, 1972 inasmuch as [redacted] has observed lights on in the apartment and has heard the radio playing also.

[redacted] does not have a key to Apartment 1-W, 306 East 6th Street nor to any of the apartments in the "slum" apartments [redacted] in the lower east side of Manhattan in order to avoid false accusations from tenants in the event of burglaries in the apartments which are not uncommon in that area. He mentioned that tenants supply their own locks to their apartments.

On 2/2/72 [redacted] advised that he is [redacted] as a [redacted] at the apartment buildings operated by [redacted]

[redacted] identified a photograph of HEMBLEN as that of the latest occupant of Apartment 1-W, 306 East 6th Street. He recalled that HEMBLEN had been absent from the apartment since about mid-December, 1971 but that he observed her at that location about two weeks ago. He has not seen her at this location since that time [redacted]

[redacted] in order to determine who was residing in the apartment. On 2/2/72, he attempted this by knocking on the door to the apartment but received no reply although there was a light in the apartment.

On 2/3/72, [REDACTED] 78 West 11th St., NYC NY [REDACTED] was interviewed at his apartment in that building. [REDACTED] was previously interviewed on 1/7/72 in connection with an anonymous phone call that same day, to the NYO, alleging that a [REDACTED] at 78 West 11th St., was involved in the BANKBOM matter which occurred that same date. It was ascertained at that time that [REDACTED] resided in [REDACTED] at that location. NY file re [REDACTED] reflects that he has been engaged principally in May Day Collective activities since mid-1971. [REDACTED] in the latter part of 1971, was identified by reliable sources as the "boyfriend" of CAPBOM suspect [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was then eliminated from consideration as a BANKBOM suspect in view of obvious discrepancies between his handwriting and that of the BANKBOM subject (now identified as [REDACTED]).

[REDACTED] on 2/3/72, advised that [REDACTED] is still the registered occupant of Apt. 18, but he has not seen [REDACTED] in approximately eight weeks. He advised that [REDACTED] has lived there with a young white female, name unknown. He also stated that [REDACTED] mother [REDACTED] stays at that apartment from time to time.

[REDACTED] was interviewed on 1/7/72 in connection with the BANKBOM matter mentioned above. She stated that [REDACTED] has not been in NY for two weeks and that he is going to school over 1,000 miles away from NY. She was adamant in her refusal to name this school or [REDACTED] new residence. She also refused to furnish any other information about him.

[REDACTED] on 2/3/72 was shown a photograph of [REDACTED]. He identified [REDACTED] as the girl that [REDACTED] resided with in Apartment 18. When asked when he last observed [REDACTED] he advised that he thought he saw her in the hallway with [REDACTED] on 1/30/72.

[redacted] was also shown a photograph of CAPDOM suspect JUDITH HEMBLEN. [redacted]

[redacted] could furnish no other data re HEMBLEN.

[redacted] He did not give the impression of being senile, but his ready identification of the photographs of HAGON and HEMBLEN gave grounds to suspect his information.

[redacted] NY has obtained the identities of the occupants of the three other apartments on the fifth floor (the location of Apt. 18). Background is being developed, and any people likely to be cooperative will be interviewed re [redacted] information.

For the information of New Haven, [redacted] is the subject of NY file [redacted] in view of his Bay City Collective activities.

[redacted] NY previous investigation [redacted] his father to be a [redacted] Connecticut.

[redacted] must be interviewed re any knowledge he may possess re CAPDOM. It should be borne in mind that he resided with suspect [redacted] subsequent to the occurrence of CAPDOM. In view of their amorous relationship [redacted] may have confided any involvement she may have had in CAPDOM to [redacted]

It is further noted that [redacted] a reliable source familiar with [redacted] or [redacted] advised that source has not seen or heard anything regarding [redacted] in the past two months, and he appears to have dropped out of the "Movement" in the NYC area.

Photos of [REDACTED] and JUDITH LEE HEMBLEMEN were furnished, and [REDACTED] were advised of the Bureau's intense interest in establishing, and maintaining, the whereabouts of the above three individuals. Records kept at the [REDACTED] were reviewed and nothing indicating any sort of disturbance at Apt. 18, 78 West 11th St., was located. [REDACTED] were also unable to furnish any sort of positive data after viewing the photos, but stated that they would contact the FBI if any of the above three would be observed in the area of 78 West 11th St. in the future.

[REDACTED] was told by the interviewing agent that the matter under investigation was of extreme importance and he indicated that he would cooperate in any way possible. He was instructed to notify the FBI upon [REDACTED] observing any individuals [REDACTED]. He stated he would do so [REDACTED]

NYO indices negative re [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Further verification of their background is being conducted.

It is also noted that during the course of the investigation conducted at 73 West 11th St on 2/7/72 an attempt was made to interview the registered occupants of apartment a [REDACTED] had previously advised that [REDACTED]

The occupants of [REDACTED] responded to a knock on the door but refused to open the door when advised of the FBI's presence. In a brief conversation through the door it became obvious these people would not be cooperative in any way and no further efforts were made to interview the occupants of apartment [REDACTED]

Additional review of the bulky exhibit section, CAPBOM, showed that NY is in possession of the hair specimen questioned.
