It is possible that the INS information was based upon the [REDACTED] story as appearing in another edition and including the pertinent reported admission on the part of Hemblen. Suggest that if INS has copies of the two news stories involved, New York obtain same.

NOTE:

Hemblen is one of eight principal suspects in bombing of U. S. Capitol 9/1/71. She is an alien and we are exploring possibility of having INS pass its "Exclusion Proceedings" for what value it might be in solution of CAPBOM.

On 9/20/69, at an SDS meeting at Boston University, Boston, Mass., [REDACTED] was one of the three main speakers. Also speaking at this event were [REDACTED] who, in his speech, advocated revolution and stated this revolution would be by violence. [REDACTED] in her speech, attempted to re-enforce arguments made by [REDACTED] and spoke only for a short time.

On 1/14/70 information was received that [REDACTED] attended a meeting in New York City at which [REDACTED] founder of YIP party, was to speak, however, [REDACTED] did not show up. The meeting consisted of lectures from three speakers, the primary topic of which was a Japanese radical group crying more American radical activities. After the meeting broke up the group proceeded to the Waldorf Astoria Hotel, Park Avenue, N. Y., and demonstrated against Japanese Premier SATO. [REDACTED] was among those demonstrators.

During February, 1970, [REDACTED] traveled to Cuba as a member of the Second Venceremos Brigade (VB). She returned to the U. S. from Cuba the end of April, 1970.

On 5/23/70, [REDACTED] was seen associating with [REDACTED] a known Weatherman, in the Boston area.

On 2/10/71, [REDACTED] appeared at a rally held on Boston Common, Boston, Mass., to demonstrate opposition to invasion of Laos. After the demonstration, approximately 800 of the 4,000 demonstrators engaged in "trashing" the Boston PD. Numerous officers were injured. Fourteen arrests were made. Participating in this demonstration was [REDACTED] who was accompanied by two known Weathermen. During this time subject resided at [REDACTED]

As of 3/4/71, [REDACTED] is located residing at Apartment 3, 2 Albermarle Court, Boston.

On 3/6/71, [REDACTED] moved into this apartment with [REDACTED]. Also [REDACTED] in this apartment at that time was [REDACTED]. It is noted that [REDACTED] are residents of this apartment during the visits by [REDACTED] on 3/30-31/71.

Between the first week in March, 1971, and April, 1971, [REDACTED] were observed almost daily exiting and entering the Albermarle Ct. apartment.

During March, 1971, the May Day Office, located at 68 St. Stephen Street, Boston, Mass., was distributing fliers promoting the YIP conference in Madison, Wisconsin, 4/1-4/71 and that this operation was under the guidance of HEMBLER and [REDACTED] who were utilizing space in the Boston PCP's office. It was also reported that [REDACTED] a former

Weatherman, and [REDACTED] a Weatherman from Cleveland, Ohio, were the individuals directing the operation of the May Day Tribe, 67 St. Stephen St., Boston, Mass.

On 5/26/71, it was reported that individuals operating out of 68 St. Stephen St. had vacated these premises and had not established a base elsewhere.

On 4/5/70, PCPJ held a mass meeting in Boston to plan a "militaristic action" on 5/5/70. At this meeting was [REDACTED]

On 6/10/71, [REDACTED] still resided at Apartment 3, 2 Albermarle St., Boston.

On 7/21/71, [REDACTED] continued to reside at Apartment 3, 2 Albermarle St., Boston, and sources reported having no information regarding her activities for the past two months.

On 7/30/71, [REDACTED] had not been seen in the vicinity of 2 Albermarle St. for two weeks and based on observation it was believed that [REDACTED] was no longer residing at that address.

On 8/9/71, [REDACTED] moved from Apartment 3, 2 Albermarle St. to 150 St. Dunlop St., which is located around the corner from that address. Investigation determined that the occupants of [REDACTED] were [REDACTED] individuals strongly associated with the demonstration by Boston Agents at a demonstration held on 9/15/71.

On 9/15/71, [REDACTED] was observed at a demonstration in front of the John F. Kennedy Federal Building, Boston, Mass. The demonstration was held to protest the manner in which the riot by prisoners at Attica State Prison, Attica, N.Y., was handled. Among those who spoke were [REDACTED]

Self admitted member of Weatherman Faction of SDS. Arrested New Haven, Conn., 4/26/70 for trespassing at which time he was in possession of welding equipment, pipes, electrical tools, and a box of .22 caliber

This explosion was the one which is reported to have killed three members of Weatherman Faction of SDS at the Wilkerson Townhouse. During February, 1970, [REDACTED] attended karate classes with other members of Weatherman Faction of SDS.

3/6/71 Hemblen moved into this apartment with [REDACTED] also living in this apartment at that time was [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] Hemblen [REDACTED] were residents of the apartment during visits by [REDACTED] 3/30-31/71. The obvious closeness of these individuals, two of whom are principal suspects in the CAPBOM case, in the 30 days immediately following the U. S. Capitol bombing, indicates the necessity for intensified investigation of [REDACTED]

Bureau therefore agrees with Boston's intention to intensify investigation of [REDACTED] with a principal aim of determining whether or not he may have been a participant in the bombing of the U. S. Capitol.

Following concerns Boston's recommendation that [REDACTED] be considered for addition to list of eight principal suspects in the CAPBOM case. Primarily for administrative reasons, Bureau does not desire to so classify [REDACTED] at this time. However, this in no way minimizes the necessity for intensive investigation of [REDACTED] as discussed in prior correspondence from the Bureau and as indicated in referenced Boston airtel. Do continue to intensify investigation of [REDACTED] and should firm evidence appear that she was actually involved in the bombing, restate your recommendation for including her among the principal suspects.

ReBSairtel 3/27/72, copies to New York and WFO, dual captioned concerning CAPBOM and Hemblen, which submitted another specimen of Hemblen's signature and handprinting. Boston determined that still other specimens are available at a Volkswagen dealer but the dealer refused to make them available without a court order or subpoena. In addition, Boston determined that a signature specimen of Hemblen is available at the Registry of Motor Vehicles but the employee there would not permit the specimen to leave the premises. Boston set out leads for WFO to consider possibility of obtaining a subpoena duces tecum to obtain specimens from the Volkswagen dealer and to also consider possibility of obtaining specimen from Registry of Motor Vehicles.

Following are observations of the Bureau Laboratory relative to the sufficiency of specimens already submitted. Item #2 in New York airtel 3/23/72 is an INS Form N-585. It is not of sufficient clarity. Either obtain a clearer Xerox or secure a photograph. Item #5 is a signature of Hemblen appearing [REDACTED]. It, too, lacks clarity and a photograph should be obtained. Laboratory also suggests the obtaining of specimens of random script writing of Hemblen such as social correspondence, school papers, and the like.

New York is instructed to comply with Laboratory's suggestions concerning the previously referred to items numbered 2 and 5. Both Boston and New York are instructed to attempt to obtain specimens of the random nature suggested by the Laboratory.

Following are additional observations concerning Boston's handling of this matter. As outlined earlier in this communication, Bureau's request of Boston to obtain the desired specimens first made by letter 10/18/71. Not having been obtained by Boston, it was necessary for Bureau to again write on 2/24/72. Still having received no reply from Boston, it was necessary for Bureau to dispatch an airtel on 3/22/72 requesting a reply from Boston. Boston's airtel of 3/27/72 reports only the following efforts: On 3/14/72 specimens were obtained from a bank and on the same day the unproductive effort previously described was made of a Volkswagen dealer. Also on that day was made the unproductive effort at the Registry of Motor Vehicles. In summary, Bureau requests were made 10/18/71, 2/24/72, and finally followed 3/22/72. Yet, it appears that the only efforts made were on 3/14 and 27/72. This certainly is not in compliance with Bureau airtel to personal attention of all SACs 12/22/71 in the CAPBOM case urging immediate handling of all leads concerning CAPBOM and the eight principal suspects, of whom Hemblen is one. It is fully expected that the bringing of this matter to the personal attention of the SAC, Boston, will prompt such thoroughness and timeliness in its future handling of all aspects of these cases, that it will not again be necessary to write Boston in this vein.

FITZPATRICK, SDNY, for the purpose of clarifying his written reports in the matter of the conspiracy to bomb the First National City Bank, 91st Street and Madison Avenue, New York City. Six individuals were arrested by the NYCPD on 12/4/70 in the immediate vicinity of the bank and all six have since pleaded guilty in state court and have been sentenced. [REDACTED] who was not present with the other six on 12/4/70, but who allegedly involved herself in this conspiracy, has been indicted at the SDNY and trial date is now set for 5/15/72.

According to AUSA FITZPATRICK, no changes have been made in the trial date as of 3/28/72, but a conference is scheduled at the SDNY in the [REDACTED] matter on 4/13/72, for the purpose of hearing motions.

A lead is set forth below for Seattle to furnish any information re [redacted] reaction to her short incarceration there while testifying before the Federal Grand Jury in May, 1971.

On 4/27/72, [redacted] Immigration and Naturalization Service, New York City, reviewed the INS file on JUDITH LEE HEMBLEN. [redacted] the INS representative assigned to HEMBLEN matter in New York, who has been contacted in the past at New York, is presently recuperating from a heart attack. However, [redacted] located the two Washington, D.C. news articles questioned in Bureau airtel to New York, 4/4/72. [redacted] advised that the article written by [redacted] as contained in the INS file at New York, does not, in fact, contain any direct statement that HEMBLEN travelled to North Vietnam or Hanoi. The news article written by [redacted] is identical to the article previously obtained by Washington Field.

During the week beginning 5/1/72, the appropriate sections of REMBLEN's INS file, containing handwriting samples, will be photographed. These will be forwarded to the Laboratory along with the copies of the unknown handwriting previously obtained at New York for comparison.

Referenced San Francisco airtel of 3/31/72, set forth a call to New York City charged to a telephone in San Francisco that suspect [REDACTED] has access to. The call was placed to New York City telephone 924-7800. This number is currently listed to the New York Civil Liberties Union, 84 Fifth Avenue, New York City, New York. Due to the nature of this organization, no further investigation was conducted. San Francisco should be in a position to evaluate whether [REDACTED] presently requires legal assistance of the type offered by the Civil Liberties Union.

However, recent issues, to stimulate reader interest, have featured anti-establishment, anti-US involvement in Vietnam type articles. It is a tabloid type newspaper, published approximately ten times a year by the Entelechy Press Corporation, 2929 Broadway, New York City, New York.

The attention of the Bureau is directed to page eleven wherein an article "Meeting the Indochinese", by "JUDY GUMBO" appears. "JUDY GUMBO" is the commonly known alias for CAPBOM suspect JUDITH LEE HEMBLEN. The top of the second column begins her statements of her travel to North Vietnam in the summer of 1970. The photo included in the article includes HEMBLEN, front row, third from the left.

The Bureau may wish to disseminate the publication to INS at Washington, D.C. for their use in the exclusionary proceedings now pending against HEMBLEN. New York will furnish a copy locally to INS.

On April 8, 1972, approximately 125 demonstrators gathered at Lafayette Park, Washington, D. C. to protest United States continued military involvement in Southeast Asia. A Special Agent (SA) of the FBI observed various anti-war organizations speak to those assembled. Among the speakers was [REDACTED] who is on the National Steering Committee of the PCPJ.

The PCPJ is self-described as being headquartered at 156 Fifth Avenue, NYC, NY, and as consisting of over 100 organizations which are using massive civil disobedience to combat racism, poverty, repression, and war.

On April 15, 1972, an SA of the FBI overheard [REDACTED] say that she was then residing at Apartment 32, 1801 Colbert Street, Northwest, Washington, D. C.

III. ACTIVITY

The current issue of a publication known as "University Review" as obtained by an SA of the FBI in NYC on April 19, 1972, contained an article entitled "Meeting the Indochinese", with the byline of "Judy Gumbo." Included in this article are the following paragraphs:

"I had visited North Vietnam in the Summer of 1970. For three weeks I lived in the midst of a revolutionary society. I learned how people who fight together against a common enemy respect each other. From a group of 17-year old women artillery gunners I learned about revolutionary patience. They explained that you don't necessarily shoot at the first United States plane you see, even though it might bomb and destroy. Instead, you wait until there is a clear shot and you are certain of downing the plane....."

"The Vietnamese had welcomed us to their liberated territory, educated us about the war, fed us, and entertained us, on the eve of their most significant festival - at a time when the United States (US) Government was trying to destroy their nation."

The "University Review" is described as a free distribution "throwaway" circulated in such manner on college campuses. Its basic format relates to book reviews, musical recording reviews and the development of recording equipment. However, recent issues, to stimulate reader interest, have featured anti-establishment, and anti-US involvement in Vietnam type articles. It is a tabloid type newspaper published approximately ten times a year by the Entelechy Press Corporation, 2929 Broadway, New York City, New York.

INS is aware of the transient nature of Hemblen and was told of our most recent information to the effect she was planning to go to Miami, Florida, (see New York airtel to Bureau, Miami and WFO, 5/19/72).. INS indicated that if difficulty was encountered in locating Hemblen it would seek assistance by having its office in New York City contact the FBI office there.

Purpose of this communication is to alert recipients to the above-described contemplated action of INS. New York and the Bureau should be kept advised on an urgent basis of any information developed concerning Hemblen's whereabouts.

NOTE:

Hemblen is one of eight principal suspects in bombing of U. S. Capitol, 3/1/71. Information in above obtained from INS [redacted] during a conference between Supervisors [redacted] with [redacted] INS. [redacted] was told that we would lend all possible support in keeping INS advised as to Hemblen's whereabouts. The following, for record purposes, relates to INS' contemplative action. It had been deliberating whether to move against Hemblen through an Exclusion Proceedings or through a Deportation Proceedings. INS is not very optimistic about being successful in having her excluded because it will be necessary to prove that she knew she was not permitted to travel to North Vietnam and to the USSR when she made such travel. (This is the heart of their case against her). [redacted] also indicated that the fact we had asked for an appointment to discuss the case with him in effect got them moving towards some positive action as described above. Hemblen is a native of Canada and is in the U. S. with permanent residence status as an alien.

A confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised [REDACTED] that Judy Gumbo, as of that date, was residing in New York City. [REDACTED]

Set forth below is a summary of the activities of Hemblen in the recent past:

Hemblen was a leader of the Youth International Party (YIP) in New York City, during 1970. In late 1969, she and Stewart Albert, also a member of the YIP, traveled to Algiers, Algeria, and were guests of Black Panther leader, [REDACTED] Hemblen left the United States in early May of 1971 for Hanoi, North Vietnam; Moscow, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics; and Paris, France.

In Moscow Hemblen was observed at the United States Embassy in Anti-Southeast Asia War Demonstration, wearing jewelry allegedly made from United States Aircraft downed over North Vietnam, black pajamas, and a straw coolie hat.

In Paris, Hemblen was in direct contact with high North Vietnamese Peace Committee officials and allegedly received Prisoner Of War letters during her trip abroad for distribution to United States families.

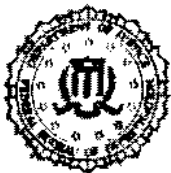

JUDITH HEMBLEN is involved with the Youth International Party (YIP), but involved with a women's group associated with the MCC.

The women's group is also known as the Women's Coalition. This coalition is actually a gathering of women from various organizations, primarily the MCC, with others from the People's Coalition for Peace and Justice (PCJP), YIP, and the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC).

The YIP, also known as "YIPPIES", is a loosely knit, anti-establishment revolutionary youth organization, formed in New York City in January, 1968.

SCLC, founded by the late Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., is headquartered at Atlanta, Georgia.

Set forth below is a brief summary of the New Left
and Extremist type activity on the part of Judith Lee Hemblen.

Hemblen, commonly known as Judy Gunbo, was a Youth
International Party (YIP) leader in New York City, during 1970.

Youth International Party (YIP)

The YIP, also known as Yippies, is a
loosely-knit, anti-establishment,
revolutionary youth organization formed
in New York City, in January, 1968.

She attended the Eighth World Festival of Youth,
Helsinki, Finland, 1962, sponsored by the World Federation of
Democratic Youth and International Union of Students, both
International Communist fronts.

In late 1969, Hemblen and Stewart Albert, also a
YIP member, travelled to Algeria, Algeria and were guests of
Black Panther Leader [REDACTED] and his wife,
[REDACTED]

Hemblen left the United States in early May of 1970,
for Hanoi, North Vietnam; Moscow, Union of Soviet Socialist
Republics; and Paris, France. In Moscow, she was observed at
the United States Embassy in an anti-Southeast Asia War
Demonstration wearing jewelry allegedly made from United States
aircraft downed over North Vietnam, black pajamas and a straw
coolie hat. In Paris, she was in direct contact with high
North Vietnamese Peace Committee officials and allegedly
received American Prisoner of War letters during her trip
abroad for distribution to United States families.

Hemblen was in Havana, Cuba during August and early September, 1970, to attend YIP - North Vietnam Cultural Exchange Program Meetings.

Hemblen also attended the YIP National Convention called the New Nation Conference held in Madison, Wisconsin, April 1 through 4, 1971.

Hemblen was approached for interview by Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation on May 30, 1972, and she flatly refused any comment.

Set forth below are two separate newspaper articles, both dated September 22, 1970, which appeared in "The Washington Post" and "The Washington Daily News", containing those newspapers' coverage in Washington, D.C. of a press conference given by Hemblen using the name of Judy Gumbo:

ALL INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN NEW LEFT EXTREMIST ACTIVITY SHOULD BE CONSIDERED DANGEROUS BECAUSE OF THEIR FUROR ADVOCACY AND USE OF LEADERSHIP. REPORTED NEGOTIATION OF FIREARMS AND INCENDIARY DEVICES, AND AWARE PROPENSITY FOR VIOLENCE.

However, the following information is being provided to the Bureau as requested. This information has been developed as a result of intensive investigation since submission of last report. During March and April, 1972, a photographic tour was conducted at [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] which is the residence of [REDACTED] also residing with her at that address are [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] During the period of the tour, among others frequenting that address were [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The results of this tour were submitted to Bureau by airtel dated 5/9/72, dual captioned CAPBOX and WEATHERSUG.

On 4/13/72, [REDACTED] Framingham House of Correction, Framingham, Mass., advised that on 3/22/72 a riot broke out at that House of Correction brought about by agitators not confined to that institution. These agitators are known as the Law Commune and located at 698 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, Mass. Members of the Law Commune have visited inmates at the prison before and are required to sign a visitor's sheet. [REDACTED] has signed in on several occasions to visit inmates and given her address as that of the Law Commune.

On 4/18/72, [REDACTED] observed a demonstration on Tremont Street in Boston during which approximately 1,500 individuals had gathered. This group, upon being denied entrance to the Armed Forces Recruiting Center on Tremont Street in Boston, were led through Boston across to Cambridge, Mass., by a group carrying the banner "Albica Brigade." Among the individuals observed in this lead group was [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] This group leaving the majority of demonstrators marched to the Center for International Affairs Building, Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass., at which time the demonstrators participated in "trashing," entered the building, destroyed files, broke windows, and attempted to set it on fire. [REDACTED] was observed with this group entering the CIA Building.

On 4/24/72, [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] in addition to entering CFIA building, was seen throwing rocks at the building from the street. Upon leaving the building she was heard to state, "This is better than last time," apparently referring to the Weatherman takeover of the CFIA Building during October, 1969.

On April 28, 1972, [REDACTED] and approximately forty other individuals participated in the mass takeover of a news studio at TV station WBZ, Boston, Mass. In order for this station to continue broadcasting, the Boston Police were called in and all individuals were arrested. All were fined \$10 on 5/16/72 in Brighton District Court. The Boston office is presently conducting investigation under individual case files of all the participants in the WBZ takeover not previously being investigated by the Boston office.

On 5/11/72, [REDACTED] along with approximately 100 other individuals, after arriving at an ongoing demonstration of approximately 500 individuals at the Joan F. Kennedy Federal Building, Boston, proceeded to lead this group to the campus of Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), Cambridge, Mass., at which time this group attempted to obstruct Massachusetts Avenue, a main artery in Cambridge, Mass., and Boston and Maine Railroad tracks serving the area. It was necessary for the Cambridge Police Department to use tear gas to disperse the crowd. It is noted that, although the nucleus group of 100 individuals of which [REDACTED] were part did not carry Attica Brigade signs, Agents observing noticed a major percentage of these individuals to be the same as those who comprised the earlier group which marched on 4/18/72.

On 5/19/72, following the bombing of the Pentagon, a check by [REDACTED] at 89 Amory Street, Cambridge, Mass., determined from an individual who refused to identify herself that [REDACTED] had been in Boston until 5/18/72 but had left Boston during the afternoon of that date, but the individual refused to say where he had gone.

On 5/24/72, the Boston office determined that [redacted] had returned to Boston on 5/23/72 from Friendship Airport, Baltimore, Maryland, aboard Flight 858 and upon making reservations for that flight listed confirmation telephone number as [redacted]. Appropriate leads were immediately set forth to the Baltimore office, by teletype captioned PENBOM.

On 5/25/72, the Baltimore office determined that information regarding that flight was contained in Washington, D. C., and reset appropriate leads. Boston still awaiting results of that investigation. Baltimore further advised that confirmation telephone number is listed to [redacted].

An attempt was made to interview [redacted] at the above address and he stated he had nothing to say to the FBI or anyone connected with the FBI.

On 5/24/72, repeated attempts were made at [redacted]

to interview both [redacted] and [redacted] regarding their knowledge of PENBOM, but they and other individuals occupying their apartment refused to open the door. After repeated attempts, [redacted] and [redacted] were confronted on the street in front of [redacted] at which time they advised they did not wish to be interviewed and introduced their attorney, [redacted] of the Law Commune, [redacted] who advised SA's that they did not wish to speak with them. The interview was then terminated. It is noted that [redacted] previously mentioned as an associate of both [redacted] is employed at [redacted].

[redacted] apparently claims to have received a call shortly after 1 a.m. on 5/19/72 from a Weatherman who claimed Weatherman was responsible for the bombing of the Pentagon. [redacted] when interviewed advised that she was the one who took this call. The Boston office is presently attempting to interview various station personnel to resolve this matter but has been hampered in its investigation by the obvious uncooperative attitude by all individuals connected with this station. Bureau was advised off above by teletype dated 5/21/72 captioned PENBOM.

Between 5/23 and 5/25/72, all individuals mentioned above were contacted by SA's of the Boston office in an attempt to interview them regarding their knowledge of PENBOM, CARBOM, and the Hermann Building bombing. With the exception of [redacted] who made a brief statement then refused to discuss the matter further, all the above individuals refused to talk with Agents and in most cases referred SA's to their attorneys, those attorneys being members of the Law Commune, mentioned above. In a number of cases these individuals with their attorneys present refused to be interviewed by SA's of the Boston office. Appropriate FD-302's reflecting attempted interviews were designated for individual Boston files.

On 6/20/72, [redacted] and [redacted] observed a meeting at [redacted] which later grew in numbers and moved to [redacted] address being [redacted] residence and Massachusetts Avenue address being Law Commune. Among the approximately 30 individuals in attendance at this meeting, which lasted from 6 p.m. until 12 midnight, were [redacted]

[redacted] It is noted that [redacted] is the suspect in the bombing of the Hermann Building, Center For International Studies, MIT, Cambridge, Mass., 10/15/71, [redacted]

On 6/16/72, [redacted] advised that in April of this year a demonstration took place at Grand Central Station in New York City wherein individuals claiming to be part of the Attica Brigade in New York did some "trashing" in the area of Grand Central. Four or five individuals from Boston were in attendance at this demonstration. He advised that he has been in contact with individuals who took part in the attack on the Center for International Affairs at Harvard on 4/18/72 and also with individuals who took part in the trashing of MIT, Cambridge, on 5/11/72, and from what he has learned of these people, there is no formal organization in the Boston area known as the Attica Brigade. He added, however, this is not to say that there

are people here in the Boston area who would not support such actions as the Attica Brigade in New York has sponsored and, in fact, would take part in such actions.

To the best of his knowledge and from what he has determined through association with such individuals he has stated that the Attica Brigade is an offshoot of the Revolutionary Union in New York and also consists of former disenchanted YAWF members.

[REDACTED] has been targeted to determining if such an organization as the Attica Brigade exists, however, to date has been unable to show the existence of such an organization in the greater Boston area. He feels that it is a convenient slogan for individuals bent on trashing or confronting the police whenever the occasion arises rather than an organizational structure per se.

Boston plans future coverage of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] by established sources and by physical surveillances of both as circumstances dictate and as manpower, allocation allows. In addition, Boston is presently attempting through possibility of local prosecution of [REDACTED] for cashing of no-account checks depending on favorable FBI laboratory examinations, to use check writing activities as a suitable vehicle in attempts to obtain information from [REDACTED] regarding her activities, the bombing of the Hermann Building, MIT, and activities of other Weatherman nationally and in the Boston area, in particular, those individuals believed connected with CAPBOM and PENBOM.

All above mentioned individuals, with the exception of [REDACTED] are ADEX Category I subjects.

For the information of the New York Office, [REDACTED] is a law student at George Washington University, WDC, and has vocalized that he was in Chicago during the Students for a Democratic Society demonstration, 10/8 - 11/69, and was arrested (no record located).

"The Evening Star," a WDC daily newspaper, dated 6/11/71, contained an article captioned, "Radicals Say U.S. Seeks to Intimidate." The article reflects that [REDACTED] supporter of the May Day Collective, charged the Justice Department with using the Grand Jury as a means to erode the movement without risking a trial.

In addition, [REDACTED] was listed to serve as a Grand Jury witness for the People's Coalition for Peace and Justice in the area of international genocide, repression, prisons, the economy, welfare, and sexism.

the CAPBOM suspects were present at the first Convention (for example, Albert, [REDACTED] Hemblen) and it is expected that several, if not all, of these suspects will also be in Miami Beach for the second Convention.

The fact that all eight suspects are Category I ADEX subjects; have also been associated to varying degrees with violence oriented individuals and organizations; and their general anti-Vietnam War and antiestablishment pronouncements, make it imperative that their whereabouts be known on a daily basis, insofar as practical, from now until 8/25/72. All offices of origin are being held accountable for such intensified investigation as is necessary to accomplish this. This is particularly necessary concerning those subjects whose whereabouts are unknown. In addition to keeping the Bureau and Miami advised on an expedite basis of the whereabouts and activities of these subjects, it is necessary that the respective offices of origin immediately furnish to Miami sufficient information concerning these individuals to enable Miami to effect necessary coverage of them. Included should be data as to their background, description, criminal record and photograph. It is recognized that the foregoing data for Miami has already been submitted concerning Albert and Hemblen and Seattle is under separate instruction to submit data [REDACTED]. Also, San Francisco was separately instructed to submit data [REDACTED].

Remaining four subjects to be handled immediately by the respective offices of origin.

All correspondence relating to foregoing instructions should be dual captioned concerning CAPBOM and the subject involved. See Bureau airtel to all offices 12/22/71 re CAPBOM. Communications should be directed to Bureau, copies to Miami, WFO and any other interested offices.
