

Alexandria is unfamiliar with the "University Review" and/or the identity of any of the individuals associated therewith. Depending on their identity the possibility may exist that the so called "alibi" of ALBERT and/or GUMBO could be further pursued.



It is noted that while the answers to questions submitted by Alexandria were not included, it is believed that the negative replies to several of WFO's questions constitute an answer to Alexandria's questions. In view of the identity of the above source, Alexandria does not contemplate further questions and no further action is being taken in this regard.

No leads are being set out, however, Alexandria welcomes any observations of New York, Boston or Chicago.





C. Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) Exclusion Matters

On October 27, 1972, subject voluntarily appeared at INS Office, 20 West Broadway, New York City, New York, with legal counsel, PAUL CHEVIGNY, Attorney At Law, New York City, New York, for the purpose of an exclusionary hearing. Upon her lawyer's motion, the hearing was postponed until November 9, 1972; the subject was presented with exclusion order. On November 9, 1972, the exclusionary hearing was held at INS, 20 West Broadway, New York City, New York. Subject's lawyer filed a motion to suppress all INS evidence regarding the exclusion order due to the fact that the lawyer charged that INS had obtained the evidence by electronic means. On November 17, 1972, after an investigation by the Special Inquiry Section of INS, the subject was again ordered to be excluded. On November 28, 1972, the subject's attorney filed an appeal brief with INS Special Inquiry Section to nullify the exclusion order. INS is currently preparing a counter brief to be filed with the Board of Immigration Appeals which will furnish a ruling after January 1, 1973.

The Miami Conventions Coalition (MCC) was formed at a national meeting in Washington, D.C., on May 20, 1972, as a coalition of groups planning protest activity at the Democratic and Republican national conventions.

In reviewing the book, the subject specifically set forth comparisons of the role of the French Government and that of the United States Government in Vietnam; she stated that both governments were "imperialistic" in nature and set up Vietnamese "puppet governments with the help of collaborators." She delved into the socio-economic aspects of Vietnam and the political and educational reforms of that country.



ALBERT and GUMBO continue to have many unidentified visitors at their cabin on Johnson Hill Road, especially on weekends. Three tents are currently pitched on the GUMBO/ALBERT lawn and numerous unidentified individuals have been observed in the vicinity of their cabin.

On August 20 - 21, 1974, the GUMBO/ALBERT cabin was surveilled by Special Agents (SAs) of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). Numerous unidentified individuals were observed; however, no fugitives were sighted.
