

The records of the [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] were reviewed by Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and revealed the following arrest information regarding ALBERT:

ALBERT was arrested on November 30, 1966, at Oakland, California, on charges of trespassing and being a public nuisance; sentence was suspended.

ALBERT was arrested on January 14, 1967, at Berkeley, California, on contempt of court charges. The case was dismissed.

On October 24, 1968, the subject was arrested by the Oakland, California Police Department on charges of malicious mischief, trespassing, and disturbing the peace. He was subsequently found guilty of disturbing the peace and given a sentence of 30 days and \$200.00.

On February 21, 1969, the subject was arrested by the Berkeley, California Police Department on charges of obstructing walk way and was subsequently fined \$125.00.

II. ACTIVITIES

[REDACTED] that on February 15, 1972, JERRY RUBIN and the subject were guests on a talk show broadcasted over radio Station WBUS, in Miami Beach, Florida. RUBIN indicated that he and ALBERT had recently been in Chile, which he described as having more political freedom than the United States. Both ALBERT and RUBIN fielded a number of questions from the listening audience.

[REDACTED] that ALBERT and RUBIN held a press conference in front of the Miami Beach Convention Hall, on February 16, 1972. ALBERT stated that the Democrats must set a date for the end of the war in Vietnam, and that this group will demand that a date be set. Further that, he and RUBIN are going to bring as many people as they can to Miami during the Democratic Party National Convention to force the Democratic Party and their candidates to set a date for the end of the Vietnam War.

[REDACTED] that on February 5, 1972, ALBERT was a member of a group of 150 demonstrators involved in a protest demonstration at Willow Brook State School for the Mentally Retarded, Staten Island, New York. Later in the day ALBERT, JERRY RUBIN attended a demonstration at 49th Street and Fifth Avenue, New York City, protesting conditions in Ireland.

Arrested April 12, 1968 by [REDACTED] for interfering with a Police Officer, on May 3, 1968 for Battery and Resisting Arrest and on April 9, 1968, by the [REDACTED] for Battery. He has stated he has advocated the use of firearms and to further the cause of the New Left and has practiced marksmanship.






