A review of the subject's file at the New York Division, in order to determine whether or not his continued designation as a key activist is warranted, has been conducted and it has been concluded that the subject should be deleted from the Key Activist Album. It is pointed out that the subject is not a leader of any subversive or New Left organization; has participated in demonstrations on a sporadic and infrequent basis during the last year; is not an active or publicly known spokesman in the New Left movement; and, due to subject's heart ailment, it is not anticipated that subject will become active in the future.

The character of this case is being changed from SM - YIP to SM - R, and investigation is continuing concerning subject's activities.

His name, however, should be retained in the ARKX and you should continue to follow his activities in accordance with instructions relating to investigations of individuals designated as extremists. Should additional information come to your attention warranting consideration of Albert's name for future inclusion in the Key Activist List, submit your recommendation in this regard to Headquarters.

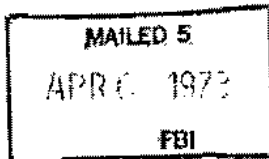

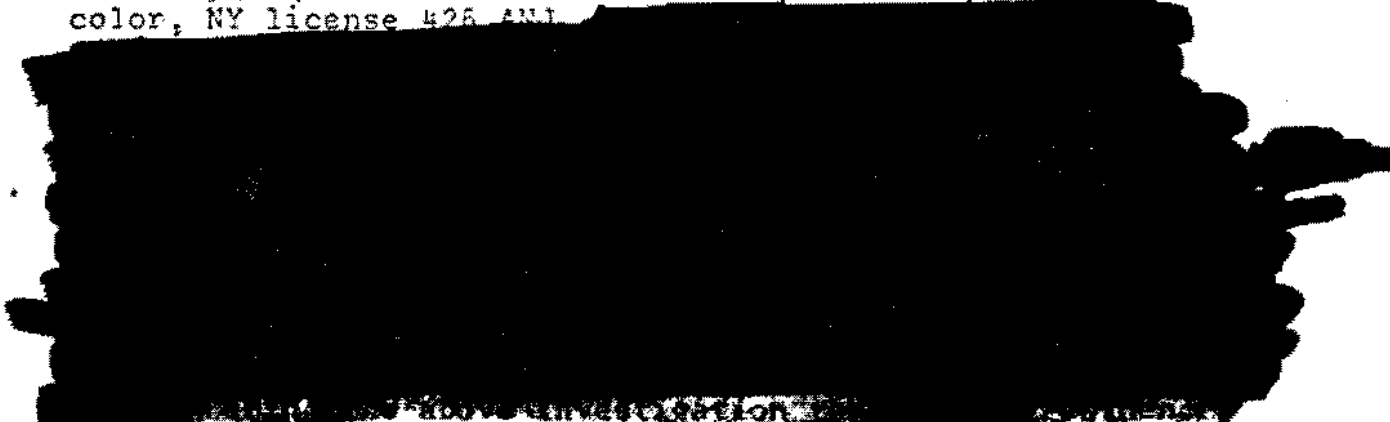

Referenced Bureau airtel pointed out that the recent connection between HEMBLEN and ALBERT and the book "Prairie Fire" indicates the NYO should intensify its investigation of these individuals. For the information of the Bureau, the NYO has, over a period of several months, been intensifying its efforts along these lines to determine exactly how HEMBLEN and ALBERT are involved with such individuals as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and what role they are playing in current YIP and Weatherman activities in this area. In an effort to accomplish this the NYO has conducted thorough and penetrative investigations utilizing all logical and imaginative techniques at its disposal. For the past several months the NYO has felt it necessary to periodically send agents to the area where the subjects reside in an effort to gain more intelligence information regarding their activities and acquaintances. The Bureau should be aware of the fact that the subjects reside in a rural area in an isolated dwelling that is accessible only by the most circumspect methods, usually at night when surveilling personnel cannot be seen. This, of course, makes complete coverage of the subjects on a 24-hour basis very difficult. In addition, HEMBLEN, who in every surveillance situation encountered to date is the person who drives when the subjects leave their residence, is known to drive at speeds in excess of 80 miles per hour on roads which are sometimes devoid of any other traffic. This also makes surveillance very difficult. Any technique employed by the NYO must, of course, be one in which the chances of the subjects becoming aware of this investigation are small. The NYO feels that if the subjects become aware of the Bureau's interest in their activities, they will most certainly cease those activities making any further investigation unproductive.

In spite of the above logistical problems, the NYO gained the following information during surveillance of the subjects from 11/1/74 to 11/17/74. [REDACTED]

This investigation confirmed the fact that HEMBLEN teaches an extension course on Thursday nights at the High School building in Ellenville, NY. Her classes are currently made up of correction officers, to whom she teaches sociology.



On Friday afternoons HEMBLEN travels to the Newark/NYC area where she teaches a Friday night and Saturday morning class at Essex County College, 31 Clinton Street, Newark, NJ. Efforts to obtain information regarding where HEMBLEN stays while in Newark have so far met with negative results. During all of these trips which have been observed by agents of the NYO, HEMBLEN has travelled to Newark alone leaving ALBERT behind in their Hurley, NY, cabin. Efforts are currently being made jointly with the Newark Office to surveill the subject during one of these trips to gather more information about her activities while in the Newark/NYC area.

Intelligence gathered by the NYO seemed to indicate that there would be some period of activity on or before the date the subjects were to leave for Canada. As can be seen from the above, the subjects' movements are completely unpredictable, making logical investigative techniques very difficult to employ. Instead of leaving on the appointed day, the subjects chose to leave three days later.

REQUEST OF THE BUREAU

In order to effect surveillance of the subjects during the summer months when experience has shown their activities increase, permission is requested to utilize an electronic "beeper" on the vehicle driven by the subjects. The Bureau should be advised that the equipment necessary to effect the above procedure is currently on inventory in the NYO, and available for use as soon as approval is received.

Agents of the NYO instituted a surveillance of HEMBLEN and ALBERT in the Hurley, NY area which began 8/25/75 and ended 9/5/75.

During that time, the electronic "beeper" referred to in referenced airtel was used. This device was initially placed on HEMBLEN's vehicle on 8/26/75, and was removed on 9/5/75. During that time the device appeared most effective enabling agents to follow HEMBLEN at a discreet distance with better results than have been obtained in the past. Although HEMBLEN's activities did not involve prolonged surveillances for any great distance the trip she did make, with the exception of one to the NYC area, were successfully observed and her contacts noted.
